

Conditions of Entry (Skill Based Competition) *that's life!* Greatest Love Story 2019 Promotion

General

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of the Conditions of Entry. Entry into this Promotion deems acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

Who can enter

2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia except employees and immediate families of the Promoter, associated companies and agencies and participating outlets. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de facto spouse, child or stepchild (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or first cousin. 3. All entrants may enter as many times as they like but only one prize will be awarded per person.

How to enter

8. Entries must include all requested contact details, a photograph and a answer to be eligible to win. Entrants may only enter in their own name. When to enter

The Promoter may select additional entries to be used as replacements in the event that the first entrants chosen as winners cannot satisfy these Conditions of Entry or take a prize.
